

Has the way we work just changed forever?

2020 Firstline Worker Pulse Survey

Without a doubt, COVID-19 will be known as **The Great Disruptor of the 21**st **Century**. But how has it truly changed the course? Will collaboration be damaged or improved going forward, with the advent of technologies such as **Zoom**, **Microsoft Teams** and **Cisco Webex**?

RealWear, the global leader in fully ruggedized headworn computers that runs on Teams, Zoom and hundreds of other apps, with support from AREA, launched its first ever Pulse Survey targeting its user base — the firstline workforce — to understand the current sentiments of the industrial workforce as a snapshot.





Of the 200 respondents, **nearly 98%**

says that COVID-19 has changed some or even every aspect of how they will work, accelerating **Digital Transformation** in their companies.

To put a fine point on it, 76% says it's accelerated Connected Worker programs, and half believe collaboration has actually improved since COVID-19.



Has that given people hope?



Almost 70% of respondents felt More nopeful for the future at the moment they took the survey.

But do they have the right tools? 90% agree or strongly agree they have the right remote tools to do their job.






78% agreed that remote tools has improved productivity in the workplace. While that's a silver lining to a pandemic, there are still 19% who disagreed that remote tools improved productivity.

This survey was conducted in the month of November in partnership with the Augmented Reality for Enterprise Alliance (AREA). There were a total of 200 respondents ranging from individual contributors in frontline capacities to senior leadership of Global 1000 companies.
